NEW DELHI  
SC relief for woman IAF officer

The Supreme Court on Thursday directed the Centre and the IAF not to release from service a woman officer who was part of Operation Balakot and Operation Sindoor, but was denied permanent commission. A bench of Justices Surya Kant and N Kotiswar Singh sought responses from the Centre and the IAF on the plea of Wing Commander Nikita Pandey, who claimed discrimination for being denied permanent commission.

SC: Consider Zudpi Jungle as forest land

The Supreme Court on Thursday declared Zudpi Jungle lands in Maharashtra's Vidarbha region as forests in line with its 1996 verdict but protected the structures existing on it for decades. A bench of CJI BR Gavai and Justice Augustine George Masih noted that "zudpi" was a Marathi word, literally translating to bushes or shrubs and "zudpi" lands meant an inferior type of unoccupied lands with bushy growth. The bench directed such lands would not be permitted to be used for compensatory afforestation unless there was a certificate of the state chief secretary regarding non-availability of non-forest land for afforestation.

3 dead, 4 hurt in wall collapse

Three labourers were killed and four injured on Friday morning as a wall collapsed during the demolition of a house in Gujarat's Mehsana district, officials said. The incident took place at Sundarpur village in Vijapur tehsil, said superintendent of police Tarun Duggal. "A side wall suddenly collapsed on labourers. The injured were rushed to a private hospital," he said, adding that Vijapur police were probing the incident. Villagers rushed to the rescue immediately after the incident and used an earthmover to pull the victims out, said a local police official.

Op Sindoor exposed Pak's support for terror: Shah

Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Friday said Operation Sindoor has exposed Pakistan because while India carried out strikes against terror bases it responded by attacking Indian citizens and military installations in a demonstration of its open support to terrorism.

Speaking during the Investiture ceremony of the Border Security Force, Shah also noted that following the operation, the world had noticed and praised the bravery, striking power and restraint of Indian Armed Forces. He also lauded the BSF for standing firm at the borders and said "Pakistan would not be able to move an inch forward because of it".

"India," Shah said, "is facing bravely the challenge of terrorism posed by Pakistan. The world has seen the bravery of our soldiers".

Shah also noted how India's response to terrorism from across the borders has changed during under the Narendra Modi government.

"There has been a shift in India's security response under the current government. Pakistan committed multiple serious provocations in the past, but previous governments failed to give an appropriate reply."

Thing changed after the Uri attack on an Army camp, he said, adding that "for the first time, we crossed the line of control, went after terrorists and conducted surgical strikes."

Thereafter following the Pulwama attack on CRPF personnel, the Indian Air Force

responded with airstrikes targeting terror infrastructure in Balakot.

"Now after the Pahalgam terror attack in which innocent pilgrims were killed brutally by Pakistan-backed terrorists in front of their families after asking their religion," Shah said, "Prime Minister Modi vowed to give an appropriate response and Operation Sindoor is that response."

Shah said "the Indian forces initially neither attacked Pakistan's military establishments nor their airbases, but only de-

molished the terrorist hide-outs responsible for heinous crimes on our soil. Our attack was solely against the terrorists. But Pakistan proved that it sponsors terrorism by considering the attack on the terrorists as an attack on itself and targeted our country's civilians and military institutions."

The Home Minister said India's air defence systems prevented much harm from coming our way and the Indian armed forces then "responded decisively by attacking their airbase, showcasing our lethal capabilities and proving their air defence system ineffective."

Shah insisted that even during this time, India did not attack any civilian locations in Pakistan. He added that "Operation Sindoor exposed the bonding between Pakistan and terrorism before the entire world".

The Home Minister also reminded Bangladesh, which is also witnessing a surge in anti-India activities, to "never forget the bravery and contributions of BSF personnel in the 1971 war".

IAF refused entry in Pak, helped flight land in J&K

Aviation watchdog DGCA on Friday said crew of the IndiGo flight from New Delhi to Srinagar on Wednesday had sought IAF permission to enter Pakistan airspace to avoid turbulence due to hailstorm but the request was rejected. Later, IAF assisted the flight to land safely at Srinagar airport by giving control vectors and groundspeed readouts.

"As per crew statement, they requested Northern con-

trol (IAF) for deviation towards left (International Border) due to weather, however, it was not approved. Later, the crew contacted Lahore to enter into their airspace to avoid the weather but the same was refused too," DGCA said. IAF sources said the Northern Area Control advised the IndiGo crew within the frame of the NOTAM, ensuring safety of aircraft. Pakistan civil aviation authorities have issued NOTAM (Notice to Airmen) shutting the country's airspace for Indian aircraft.

104-year-old life convict acquitted after 48 years

At 104, Lakhan Saroj should be spending his days surrounded by grandchildren, in quiet reflection of a long life. Instead, he just stepped out of prison—cleared of a murder charge that haunted him for nearly half a century.

In 1977, a village scuffle in Kaushambi district led to the death of a man named Prabhru Saroj. Lakhan, then 56 years old, was accused of murder along with three others. This month, after 48 years of legal limbo and repeated jail terms, the Allahabad High Court has acquitted him.

"When the fight happened, they had broken my aunt's leg. They came drunk with sticks on August 6," Lakhan recalled, his voice brittle but memory sharp.

"We had no choice but to defend ourselves. Prabhru was injured and died later."

The altercation quickly spiraled into a criminal case. Lakhan, along with Kallu, Deshraj, and Kalesar, was arrested by Sarai Akil police. Though he was released on bail shortly after, the case dragged on. In 1982, a Sessions Court in Prayagraj sentenced all four men to life imprisonment.

Entire Phagwara CIA team held for taking Rs 2.5L bribe to free drug smuggler

In a major embarrassment to Punjab's ruling Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) government and the state police, the entire team of the Crime Investigation Agency (CIA) of the Phagwara town of Punjab's Kapurthala district was arrested on Friday for allegedly taking a bribe of Rs 2.5 lakh to release a notorious drug smuggler, Hani.

According to information, the arrested police officials included CIA in-charge Sub-Inspector (SI) Bisman Singh Mahi, assistant sub-inspectors (ASIs) Nirmal Kumar and Jaswinder Singh and a constable Jagrup Singh.

According to media reports, there were several complaints against the conduct of the arrested accused police personnel following which they were under watch of the senior officials. The accused were arrested red-handed after they accepted the bribe of Rs 2.5 lakh in lieu of release of a notorious drug smuggler, Hani, who was in their custody.

Confirming the arrests, Deputy Inspector General (DIG) of police, Jalandhar range, Naveen Singla, said that the police department

has zero tolerance to corruption.

In April, the Punjab police had dismissed a woman constable Amandeep Kaur, from service, who was caught with 1771 gram heroin in Bathinda. Amandeep had caught attention with her flamboyant lifestyle as she often posted reels with her Thar on Instagram where she has over 30,000 followers.

According to sources, suspicions had been growing about the conduct of the officers, prompting a discreet inquiry. During the investigation, the team was allegedly caught red-handed accepting the bribe. The swift action has caused a stir throughout the Phagwara Police Department.

Following preliminary medical examinations, the arrested officers will be presented before a judicial magistrate. They have been booked under relevant sections of the Prevention of Corruption Act and have been suspended with immediate effect.
