Police arrest 22 in EU raids

**BRUSSELS:** Police in Italy, Austria, Romania and Slovakia arrested 22 people Thursday as part of an investigation into the suspected siphoning of hundreds millions of Euros in post-pandemic relief funds from the European Union (EU). The 600 million Euros (USD 650 million) were part of Italy's post-pandemic money, the European Public Prosecutor's Office (EPP) said. The EPP said it suspects a criminal organization of having diverted the non-refundable funds from the Italian National Recovery and Resilience Plan between 2021 and 2023.

PTI calls off Islamabad rally

**ISLAMABAD:** Citing religious reasons, jailed former Pakistan prime minister Imran Khan's party has announced cancelling its much-hyped rally that was scheduled to be held here on Saturday to demand the release of the party founder, who has been incarcerated since August last year after his conviction in various cases. Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) chairman Barrister Gohar Ali Khan took to X on Wednesday to inform his party's supporters that the decision has been taken because of the Laylat-ul-Qadr - the blessed night that Muslims seek in the odd-numbered nights of the last 10 days of Ramzan, Geo News reported.

Russia launches attack on Kharkiv

**KYIV:** Russian troops launched waves of Shahed drones against the Ukrainian city of Kharkiv overnight, killing four people and wounding 12, regional Gov. Oleh Syniehubov said Thursday. Russia attacked Ukraine's second-biggest city with at least 15 drones, some of which were shot down by air defense. Three rescuers were killed when Russia struck a multistory building damaged in an earlier strike. Six people were wounded at that location.

School constructed with Indian assistance inaugurated in Nepal

**AGENCIES Kathmandu**

A set of buildings for a government secondary school, constructed under the 'Nepal-India Development Cooperation' was inaugurated at Rawa Basi in Khotang district on Thursday, in the latest such effort by India to help improve the education sector in the Himalayan nation.

The Indian grant assistance of NR 36.10 million was utilised for the construction of a double-storied school building, hostel building and procurement of furniture for both the buildings for Shree Sharada Secondary School, Rawa Basi rural municipality in Khotang district, about 260 km south-east of Kathmandu, according to a press release from the Indian Embassy here.

The school buildings were jointly inaugurated by San Bahadur Rai, chair of the District Coordination Committee, Phatik Kumar Shrestha, the Chairman of Rawa Basi Rural Municipality and Suman Shekhar, First Secretary, Embassy of India. Established in 1952, the Sharada Secondary School provides education from Class 1 to the plus two levels and there are over 365 students, half of them girls. The project was taken up as a High Impact Community Development Project (HICDP), earlier known as Small Development Projects, under an agreement between the Government of India and the Government of Nepal. Since 2003, the Government of India has taken up over 550 (HICDPs) in Nepal in various sectors and has completed 488 projects.



After major quake, rescuers in Taiwan search for those missing

**HUALIEN (TAIWAN):** Rescuers searched Thursday for missing people and worked to reach hundreds stranded when Taiwan's strongest earthquake in 25 years sent boulders and mud tumbling down mountainsides, blocking roads. Ten people died and more than 1,000 were injured. The powerful quake struck during the morning rush hour a day earlier, sending school-children rushing outdoors and families fleeing their apartments through the windows. The ground floors of some buildings collapsed, leaving them leaning at precarious angles. Though the island is regularly rattled by earthquakes and generally well prepared, authorities did not send out the usual alerts because they were expecting a smaller tremor. Some residents of the eastern coastal city of Hualien near the epicentre were staying in tents, and the main road linking the county to the capital, Taipei, was still closed Thursday afternoon, but much of Taiwan's day-to-day life returned to normal.

Maldives still considers India as a friend: Minister

The Maldives still considers India a friend, the tourism-dependent country's economic minister has said while defending President Mohamed Muizzu's stand against the presence of "foreign soldiers" in the archipelago nation in the Indian Ocean.

Within hours of taking oath last November, Muizzu, known for his pro-China leanings, asked India to withdraw its 88 military personnel from the country, saying their presence was a threat to Maldives' sovereignty.

During an interview with Turkey-based news outlet TRT World on Wednesday, Maldives' Economic Minister Mohamed Saeed was asked whether Male can be friends with both China and India, to which he re-

sponded that Maldives is a friend of all countries, not just the two. "I think the Maldives is a friend of all the countries, not only two countries. We are a tourist country and open to the world. As a holiday destination, we are appreciated by both Chinese and Indians. As far as trade is concerned, both markets are important to the Mal-

dives," Sun.mv news portal quoted Saeed as saying. Saeed also stressed that Maldives still considers India a friend as he said: "Of course, we are friends (with both). What our president, our government and the people reject is the presence of foreign soldiers here." Muizzu has repeatedly affirmed that no Indian military personnel, not even those in civilian clothing, would be present inside his country after May 10.

While the first batch of Indian military personnel manning a helicopter has left the country, Muizzu said that the troops stationed on the second platform will be withdrawn within the current month. The Indian military personnel operating the third aviation platform will be withdrawn by May 10, he has said.

As Russia's war in Ukraine gnaws at its unity... NATO marks its 75th b'day

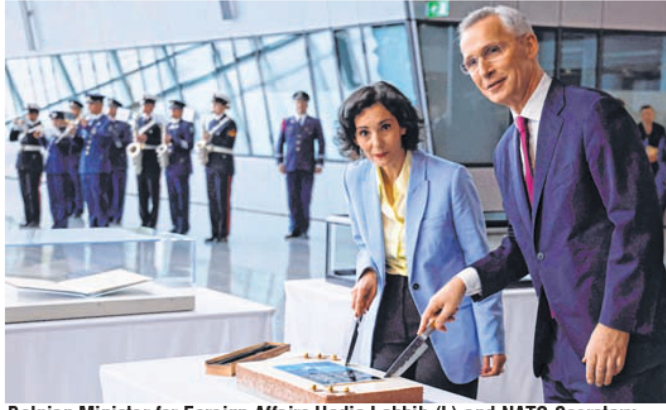
A bigger celebration is planned when NATO leaders meet in Washington from July 9 to 11

NATO marked on Thursday 75 years of collective defense across Europe and North America, with its top diplomats vowing to stay the course in Ukraine as better-armed Russian troops assert control on the battlefield.

The anniversary comes as the now-32-nation alliance weighs a plan to provide more predictable longer-term military support to Ukraine. Plagued by ammunition shortages, Ukraine this week lowered the military conscription age from 27 to 25 in an effort to replenish its depleted ranks.

"Ukraine is under heavy attacks, like daily, 24-seven," Estonian Foreign Minister Margus Tsahkna told reporters, appealing for more military materiel for Ukraine like air de-

fense systems, drones and artillery shells.

"We need to give these systems which we are not using to Ukraine, to take and protect their people, civil infrastructure and also energy infrastructure," he said, before a ceremony with his counterparts to mark the day NATO's founding treaty was signed: April 4, 1949, in Washington.

Hundreds of staffers filled the vast air terminal-like space at the centre of NATO's sprawling Brussels headquarters, while

scores of others looked down from glassed walkways and stairways as Belgian and Dutch military bands played the NATO Hymn, the original Washington Treaty laid before them.

"I like the Washington Treaty. Not least because it is very short," NATO Secretary General Jens Stoltenberg said with a smile. "Just 14 paragraphs over a few pages. Never has a single document with so few words meant so much to so many people. So much security. So much prosperity, and so much peace."

MIGRATION CONCERNS

Finland to keep its border with Russia closed until further notice

**AGENCIES Helsinki**

Finland will extend the closure of its border crossing points with Russia beyond the current April 14 deadline "until further notice" due to a high risk of organised migration orchestrated by Moscow, the Finnish government said on Thursday.

"Based on information provided by public authorities, the risk that instrumentalised migration (by Russia) will resume and expand as seen previously remains likely," the ministry said.

Finland closed the 1,340-kilometre land border late last year after more than 1,300 migrants without

proper documentation or visas - an unusually high number - entered the country in the three months since September, not long after Finland joined the NATO alliance.

Most of the migrants hail from the Middle East and Africa, from countries including Afghanistan, Egypt, Iraq, Somalia, Syria and Yemen. The vast majority of them have sought asylum in Finland, a European Union member state with a population of 5.6 million.

The Finnish Border Guard has earlier said that many migrants hold valid visas for working or studying - or have a residence permit - in Russia, which is considered a safe

country. Accusing Russia of deliberately ushering migrants to the normally heavily guarded Russia-Finland border zone that serves

also as the EU's external border in the north, the Cabinet of Prime Minister Petteri Orpo has extended the closure of checkpoints several times.

Killing of Polish aid worker in Gaza

Diplomatic crisis erupts between Poland and Israel

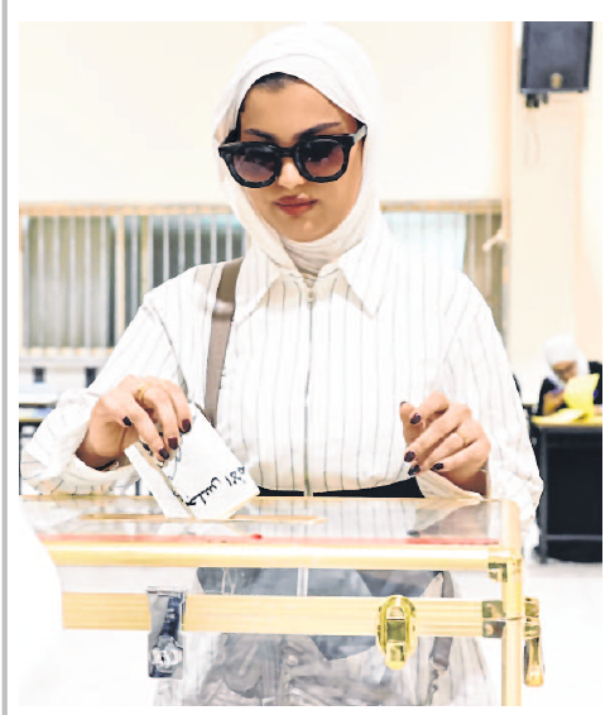
**WARSAW:** A new diplomatic crisis between Poland and Israel has erupted following the death of a Polish aid worker in Gaza, with the Polish president on Thursday denouncing a comment by the Israeli ambassador as "outrageous" and the Foreign Ministry in Warsaw saying it was summoning him for a meeting.

A 35-year-old Polish man was among seven people who were killed while delivering food to besieged Palestinians with the charity World Central Kitchen. Israel has called the incident a "mistake" that followed a misidentification. The charity said its vehicles were clearly marked.

Amid shock in Poland over the death of the charity worker, Israel's ambassador to Poland, Yacov Livne, pushed back at what he said were attempts by the "extreme right and left in Poland" to accuse Israel of "intentional murder in the attack."

KUWAIT VOTES IN ITS 4TH ELECTION



**DUBAI**

Kuwait held national elections on Thursday for the fourth time in as many years as the oil-rich country seeks to break out of its longstanding political gridlock. The Persian Gulf country's elected assembly has more power than most in the Arab world, but has long been at loggerheads with the government, which is appointed by the royal family. These are the first elections since Sheikh Meshal Al Ahmad Al Jaber, 83, assumed power after the death of his half brother in December.

SHEHBAZ: Govt will probe threat letter laced with 'suspicious powder'

**ISLAMABAD**

Pakistan Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif on Thursday said the government will launch a probe into threat letters laced with a "suspicious powder" received by judges of the Supreme Court and the high courts in Islamabad and Lahore. Eight judges of Islamabad High Court (IHC) and three judges of Lahore High Court received threatening letters with white powder suspected to be anthrax.

"The letters that were sent to various judges yesterday, and the reports that have emerged about a suspicious powder in them [.] So I think that we should show full responsibility on this and not let any kind of politics near this [matter]," Dawn News quoted the prime minister as saying during a cabinet meeting here.

"The government of Pakistan, with a sense of responsibility, will investigate this," Sharif said.

The staff of two judges, who had opened the envelopes and found a suspicious powder inside, reported the matter to the IHC registrar who summoned the police officials deputated for security of the court.

A case has been registered and according to the FIR, the letters were issued with an incomplete address of the sender.

The letters while giving reference to Tehreek-i-Namoo Pakistan criticised the justice system, with a particular photo and English word "Bacillus Anthracis" included for the threat, the FIR said. Similar letters arrived in the Supreme Court and the Lahore High Court (LHC) the next day, prompting the Counter-Terrorism Department (CTD) to register two cases in Islamabad and Lahore.

The letters in the top court were sent to Chief Justice of Pakistan Qazi Faez Isa, Justice Athar Minallah, Justice Jamal Khan Mandokhail, and Justice Aminuddin.
